This week you received by mail the “Notice of Availability of a Draft EIR for Public Review.” This notice concerns the Valley Gardens project on the golf course property adjoining Spring Lakes Park. The project, which has been in the works for some time, now seeks public input through individual written responses and participation in public meetings.

The environmental impact report, EIR, was drafted by the project’s developers in compliance with requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act, CEQA. It represents the first step toward the proposed rezoning of the site by the City of Scotts Valley.

The city is accepting written comments from now to October 14. The public meetings have not been scheduled yet. A printed copy of the draft EIR has been placed in the library (thank you to Susan Hancey) for you to peruse. The MC has been engaged with the project developers and has discussed mutual interests and the Park’s concerns. As reported at the monthly MC/Partner meetings, the developer intends to do a presentation for Park residents. That presentation is not yet scheduled because it is still in the design phase.
