#### From the MC:

- MC Meeting for April: A reminder that we have a management committee meeting this coming Tuesday, April 22 at 10 am in the clubhouse. Among the items we will be presenting is an update on the hydrologist study, and our next steps in our lake's redevelopment design.














Film & Food Class Club House
