As soon as the plaster work is completed and the start-up equipment tested, we can have the final inspection with the County and reopen the pool. Thank you again for your patience with this project, and we should be in great shape for the foreseeable future. These pool and line repairs were long-due, and very necessary. We do not have a specific re-open date. We will let you know when we are ready to open the Pool, Sauna, and Hot tub.

MAY BIRD REPORT



Our featured bird this month is the **Downy Woodpecker**.

Our smallest woodpecker has a short bill, black & white checkered wings, black & white striped head, and a broad white patch on its back. The males wear a jaunty red spot near the back of their head. A pair has been sighted here. Maybe we'll see baby woodpeckers soon?

Forty-five bird species visited our Park last month.

Highlights include California Quail, Northern Flicker, Great Horned Owl, Hooded Oriole, Double-crested Cormorant, American & Lesser Goldfinches, Western Bluebird, Ash-throated Flycatcher, Killdeer, Green Heron, Black-headed Grosbeak, Red-breasted Nuthatch, Brewers & Red-winged Blackbirds, Violet-green, Cliff, Barn & Northern Rough-winged Swallows, Purple & House Finches, Brown-headed Cowbird, Red-tailed Hawk, and Downy, Nuttall's & Acorn Woodpeckers.
