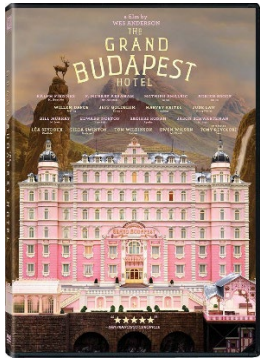

There will be no Grey Bears delivery on Thursday, July 3rd.

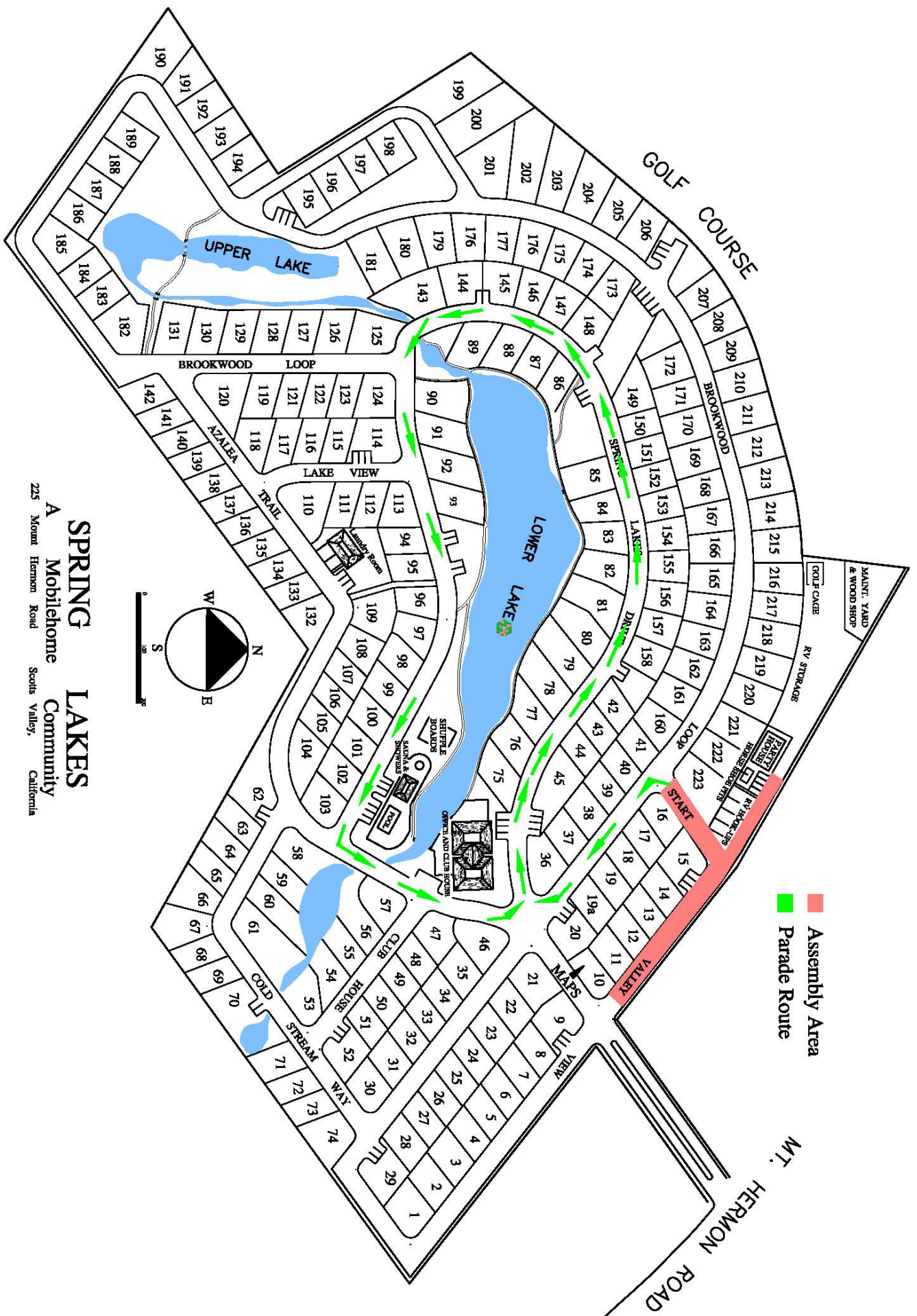
The clubhouse has been rented on Saturday June 28th for a private event, please be respectful of the space.
