Beer and soda will be available for purchase.

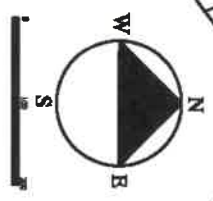

## Annual A&L Committee Home Inspections

The now annual home and yard inspections are scheduled for the week of July 15th. The A&L committee will be circulating through the neighborhoods to ensure that partners are doing their part in the maintenance and upkeep of their homes and yards. We will only be looking at the areas visible from the street, so that means that back yards will not be included in the review.

Residents who receive notice will be given two weeks to address the areas identified before a second inspection will be held. If you need more time, please notify the park manager, Jesse Rice.

Types of things that we will be looking for are:

- Weeds in yards, driveways, and rooftop gutters.
- Bent stanchions in driveways.
- General cleanliness of the outside of the home. We may be recommending a power wash to residents if we find built up dirt on the outside areas.
- Outside of home, including driveways and side yards are free of debris and clutter.
- Landscaping, such as dead plants or hedges that need trimming.
- We may recommend repainting if the outside walls are peeling or showing extreme age.
- Broken stairs or guardrails.
- Ensuring that all houses have house numbers clearly visible from the street.
- Clean mailboxes.

The names of two professionals who can clear weeds from the rooftop gutters. Those names are available in the library. Please do not try to do this work yourself; it can be dangerous to do so.
